

## **Claire Paoletti (France)**

Writer / Story-editor

After earning a degree in cinema and art history, Claire Paoletti discovered animation while supervising co-productions of children's programming for France 2 and then France 3. She decided to specialize as an animation writer, working on such numerous shows as "Tootuff" (which she adapted and story-edited), "Shteing Circus" (a series based on her own original concept), and "W.I.T.C.H." (a comic-book series which she also adapted). She wrote "Mark Logan," a 52' animated special produced by Pictor Media and broadcast on France 3 in February 2008, thanks to which she became a final contender for the Prize of Best Television Screenplay.

Claire also published a novelization of the film (Bayard Presse, 2008). Ever since 2003, she runs regular workshops at the Animation Cinema School "La Poudrière" (Valence, France).

Thanks to the support of the CNC, she's currently writing the script of an animated full-length feature film.
