IMPORTANT - SCHOLARSHIP RULES:

- Per Master, only one scholarship will be granted per company per event.
- A company which has already received a scholarship in 2026 for one of its members, is allowed to apply for a new scholarship for another member who wishes to participate in another Cartoon Master 2026, but under no circumstances will have priority over new applicants.
- For all the Cartoon Masters 2026, only one scholarship will be granted per person.
- In any other case, we will select the scholarship holders depending on their motivation and professional profile.
- The applicants must speak fluently English. Speaking the language of the country where the chosen Master is being held would be a plus.
- If the scholarship is accepted, you will have to register online using the specific code that will be sent to you upon the confirmation of your scholarship grant.

- After registration, your contract and declaration form will be sent to you for your signature.

Should you want to apply for scholarship without presenting a project at **CartoonNext**: Please return us your Scholarship form together with a motivation letter and a CV by 13 February 2026.

Attention: Scholarship candidates who need to apply for a Schengen VISA should notify Cartoon with the approval of their VISA by 13 March 2026. Any changes after this date results in room cancellation and administration fee.

Cancellation after 13 March obliges the scholarship holder to pay for the hotel costs.
