IMPORTANT - SCHOLARSHIP RULES:

- Per Master, only one scholarship will be granted per company.
- A company which has already received a scholarship in 2023 for one of its members, is allowed to apply for a new scholarship for another member who wishes to participate in another Cartoon Master 2024, but under no circumstances will have priority over new applicants.
- For all the Cartoon Masters 2024, only one scholarship will be granted per person.
- In any other case, we will select the scholarship holders depending on their motivation and professional profile.
- The applicants must speak fluently English. Speaking the language of the country where the chosen Master is being held would be a plus.
- If the scholarship is accepted, you will have to register online using the specific code that will be sent to you upon the confirmation of your scholarship grant.

In case of withdraw of your scholarship for young talents without projects applying to **Cartoon Springboard**, please confirm at the latest by 10 September 2024.

Attention: Scholarship candidates who need to apply for a Schengen VISA should notify Cartoon with the approval of their VISA before the end of September 2024. Any changes after this date results in room cancellation and administration fee.
