IMPORTANT - SCHOLARSHIP RULES:

- **For all the Cartoon Masters 2026 (CartoonNext / Cartoon Springboard / Cartoon Business), only one scholarship will be granted per person.**
- We will select the scholarship holders depending on their motivation and professional profile.
- The applicants must speak English fluently. Speaking the language of the country where the chosen Master is being held would be a plus.
- If the scholarship is accepted, you will have to register online using a specific code that will be sent to you upon the confirmation of your scholarship grant.

If you wish to **withdraw your scholarship application for young talents with projects** at Cartoon Springboard, please let us know by no later than 19 September 2026.

If you wish to **withdraw your scholarship application for young talents without projects** at Cartoon Springboard, please confirm by no later than 5 September 2026.

Attention: Scholarship candidates requiring a Schengen VISA must inform CARTOON of their VISA approval before the end of September 2026. Any changes after this date will result in room cancellations and administration fees.
